




## Quantity of CNB Research Publications






### International Comparison: Impact of Central Banks' Research

# Macroprudential Research Network (MaRs)

- WS 1) Macro-financial models linking financial stability and the performance of the economy
- WS 2) Early warning systems and systemic risk indicators
- WS 3) Assessing contagion risks
  - Total 24 papers co-authored by CNB staff (11 for WS1, 7 for WS2 and 6 for WS3)
  - Final report: presented at the ECB General Council on 20 March 2014
  - Concluding conference: Frankfurt, 23-24 June 2014

- WS 2) Firm level studies
- WS 3) Global value chains

- Survey of firms on changes in the economic environment, employment, wage-setting and price-setting practices since the 2008/2009 crisis
- Follow-up of 2007 and 2009 surveys
- 26 countries
- Czech Republic: May-June 2014
